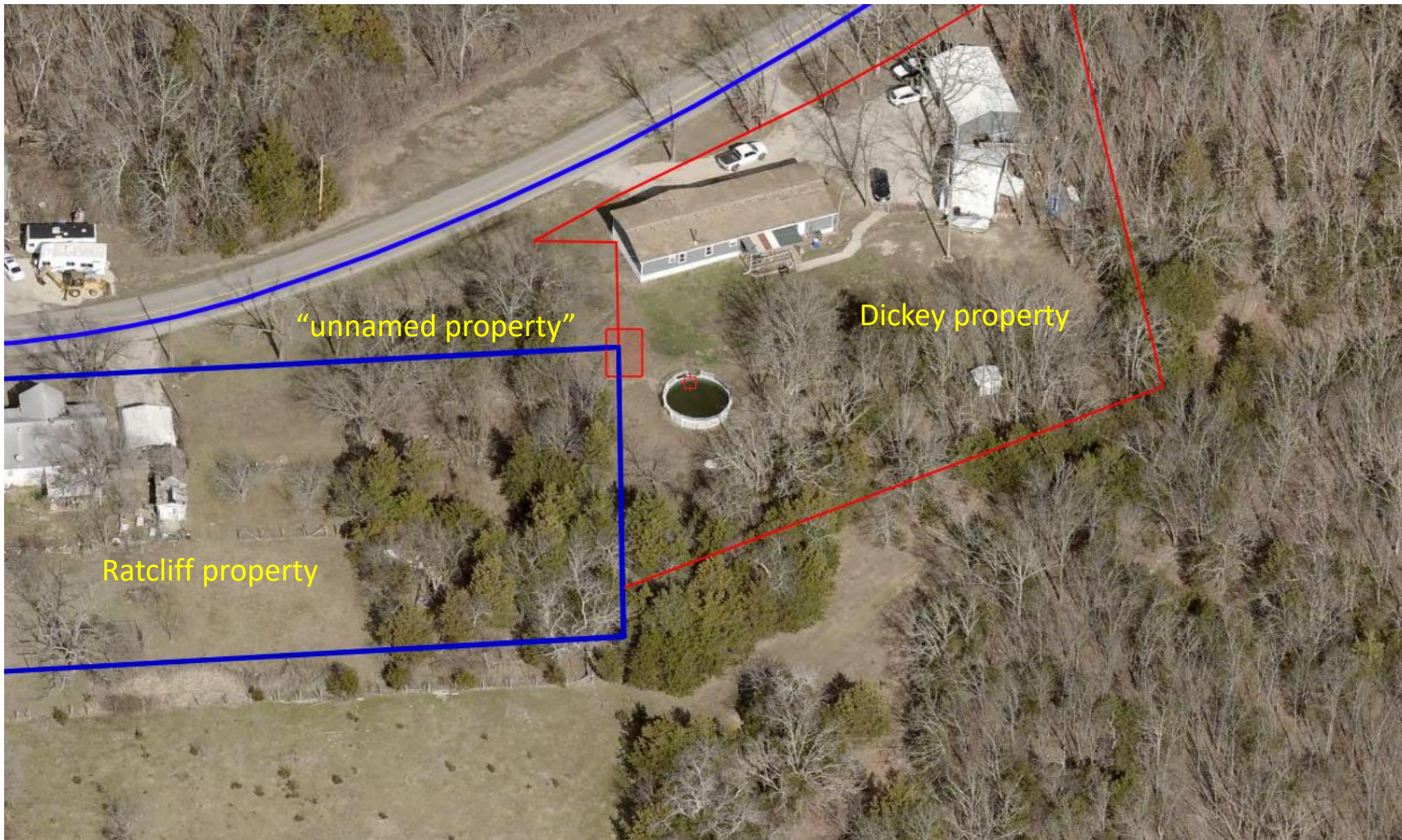

Please see the attached letter from the St. Francois County Health Center Board of Trustees Chair.

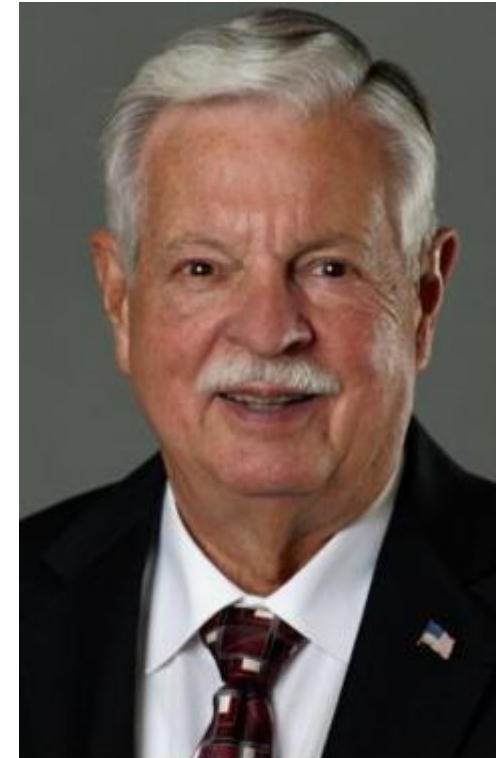
Mr. John Poston has notified the board of his resignation from the Board of Trustees.

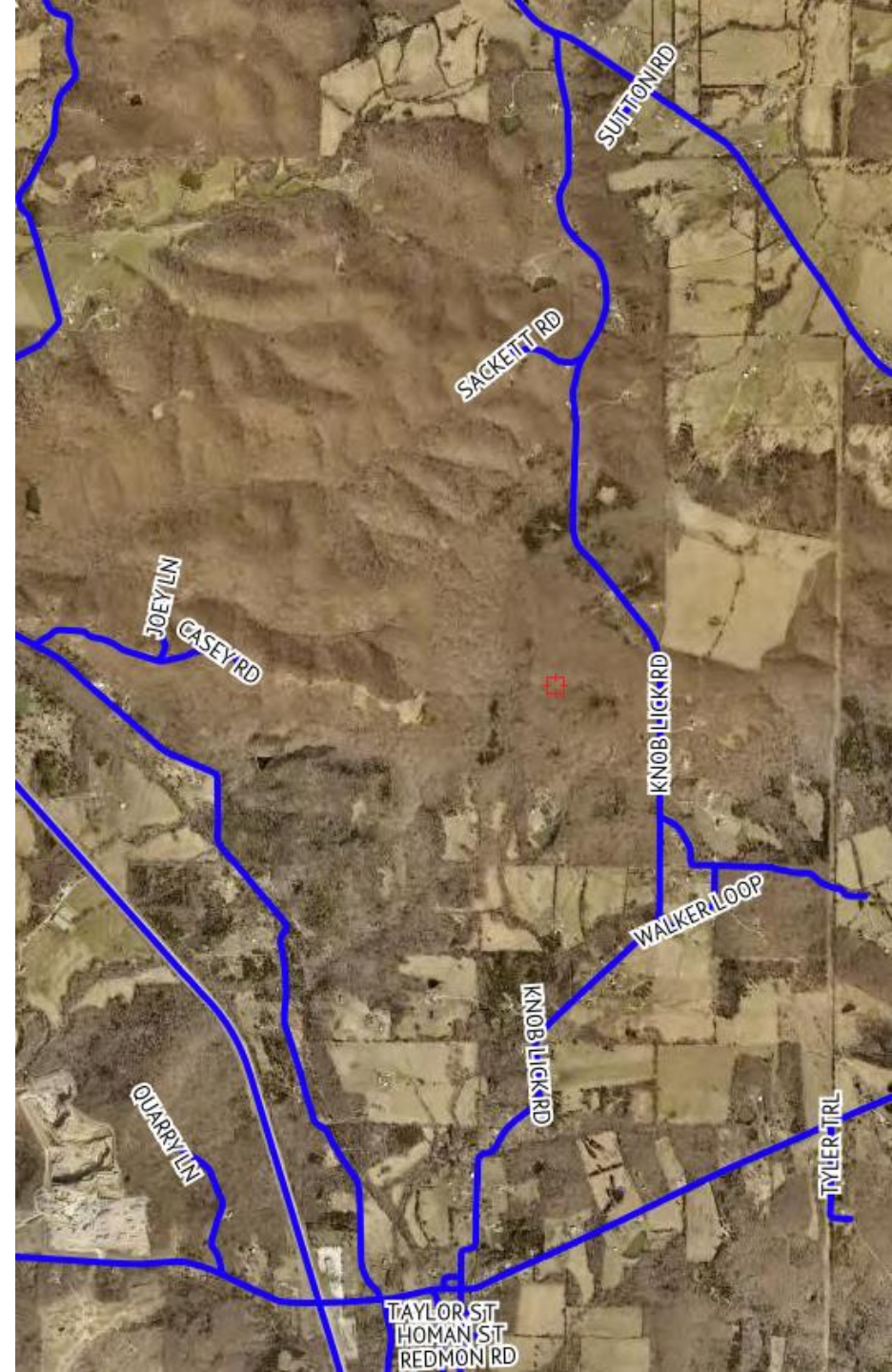
