<p>Shall the Board of Education of the Central R-III School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the betterment of school facilities including, without limitation: to construct, equip, and furnish a stand-alone safe room to house the weight room, boys and girls locker rooms, wrestling practice area, and bathrooms; to convert the current High School weight room into two classrooms to accommodate projected enrollment increases; to complete heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) upgrades at the High School; to implement safety improvements to all facilities such as camera upgrades, knox boxes that provide first responders access to buildings, and u-hooks on all classroom doors; to the extent funds are available, complete parking lot improvements at all campuses of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof?</p> <p>If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0055 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>
